

## TRIPARTITE INDUSTRIAL PEACE COUNCIL

### RESOLUTION No. 9

Series 2011

“Recommending the Ratification of ILO Convention No. 189,  
on Domestic Workers Convention, 2011”

**WE**, the representatives of organized labor, management and government in the Tripartite Industrial Peace Council (TIPC) reconstituted and with expanded membership pursuant to Executive Order No. 49 dated 09 December 1998 and Executive Order No. 97, further expanding the functions of the TIPC, dated 01 May 1999:

**WHEREAS**, the TIPC serves as a clearinghouse for the recommendation and ratification of International Labour Organization (ILO) Conventions;

**WHEREAS**, the Domestic Workers Convention, 2011, supplemented by Recommendation 201 was adopted during the 100<sup>th</sup> Session of the International Labour Conference, convened in Geneva, Switzerland;

**WHEREAS**, in recognition of the significant contribution of the Domestic Workers to the global and national economy while being prone to vulnerabilities brought about by the special nature domestic work entails;

**WHEREAS**, having convened consultations with Public and Private Recruitment Agencies, Legislative Working Groups, and other stakeholders which expressed support in the ratification of this international instrument;

**WHEREAS**, the Regional Tripartite Industrial Peace Council-IVA, Inc. endorses the ratification of ILO Convention No. 189, through the passage of RTIPC-IVA, Inc. Resolution No. 002, Series of 2011;


**WHEREAS**, a broader awareness and recognition among stakeholders have already been achieved through the various consultations done before the formulation of the Convention and Recommendation since 2010 and after its adoption by the 100<sup>th</sup> ILC in June 2011, and policies and programs instituted by the Government, partner international organizations and other non-government organizations;

**WHEREAS**, to provide decent work opportunities for formal employment and protection to all Filipino domestic workers worldwide, the Council recommends the ratification of the Convention by the Government of the Republic of the Philippines.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, AS WE HEREBY RESOLVE**, to endorse the Domestic Workers Convention, 2011, for ratification by the President of the Philippines and for concurrence by the Philippine Senate.

Approved this 24<sup>th</sup> day of November 2011, at the Occupational Safety and Health Center, Diliman, Quezon City.

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
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
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
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
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
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
  
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
