RESOLUTION NO. 7

"Reaffirming Commitment to the Implementation of the Philippine Labor and Employment Plan 2011-2016"

WHEREAS, the TIPC unanimously adopted the Philippine Labor and Employment Plan (LEP) 2011-2016 pursuant to TIPC Resolution No. 1, dated 14 April 2011, with the commitment to: 1) ensure full and active participation in the implementation of the LEP towards the realization of its defined outcomes outlined under the four pillars of decent work for inclusive growth, and 2) actively participate in the review and updating of the LEP to ensure inclusive growth through decent and productive growth;

WHEREAS, aligned with the Philippine Development Plan 2011-2016, the LEP, which was launched on 28 April 2011, represents the shared vision of hundreds of stakeholders who provided inputs on their priorities and signified commitment to work collectively to bring about positive results;

WHEREAS, after a year, the TIPC through the National Tripartite Advisory Committee (NTAC) on Decent Work, reviewed the results of the LEP implementation and came out with the **2011 Progress Report** which captured the tangible achievements initiated by the tripartite partners across the declared commitments and examined the LEP priority action points to be pushed in 2012-2013;

WHEREAS, the tripartite partners have agreed to lend support to the efforts of achieving the intended results and impact of the LEP until 2016 and beyond;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, to continue to actively participate in the development of the LEP Results Framework, a tool which contains performance indicators that will link programs, projects and activities towards achieving the decent work outcomes set under the LEP and to help realize the commitments therein;

RESOLVED FURTHER that the tripartite partners, for and in behalf of the social partners, agree to submit, through the Secretary of the Department of Labor and Employment as Chairperson of the TIPC, the results-based reports of accomplishments to relevant stakeholders, especially to the National Economic Development Authority and the President of the Philippines on an annual basis beginning 2013 reporting cycle.
