## RESOLUTION NO. 12

*Series of 2013*

### ***“Expressing Solidarity and Support for the Victims of Super Typhoon Yolanda”***

**WHEREAS**, on 08 November 2013, the Visayas and some parts of Southwestern Luzon were struck by Super Typhoon Yolanda (International Name: Typhoon Haiyan), reported to be the fourth strongest typhoon in history and the strongest storm ever recorded to make a landfall;

**WHEREAS**, as per reports of the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (NDRRMC), the super typhoon wreaked havoc in the said areas affecting around 11.2 million individuals, with more than 5,000 reported dead, approximately 26,000 injured, about 1,700 missing, and damaging around 1.21 million homes;

**WHEREAS**, the disaster council likewise reported a total of P35.2 billion worth of damage to infrastructure (P18.2 billion) and agriculture (P17 billion) as of 06 December 2013;

**WHEREAS**, the magnitude of the devastation as well as the plight of the survivors of the calamity caught the attention of both local and international communities, hence the outpouring of aid and donations to help address the immediate needs of those who were affected, as well as for the rehabilitation of towns, cities and provinces ravaged by the super typhoon;


**NOW THEREFORE, WE**, the representatives of organized labor, employers and government in the National Tripartite Industrial Peace Council (TIPC), constituted through Republic Act No. 10395 (An Act Strengthening Tripartism, Amending for the Purpose Article 275 of the Presidential Decree No. 442, as amended otherwise known as the Labor Code of the Philippines), empathize with the victims of super typhoon Yolanda, particularly the workers and employers, who have suffered and lost, not only their homes and means of livelihood, but the lives of friends, relatives and loved ones as well;

**FURTHER, WE** express our appreciation and admiration not only to those who continuously provide monetary and material aid for the super typhoon victims, but also to those who tirelessly devote their time and efforts to help usher the victims towards recovery and rebuilding;


**FINALLY, WE RESOLVE TO** manifest our continuous support for all efforts and programs, both by government and non-government organizations, local and international, which are being exerted and implemented in order to alleviate the suffering of our countrymen who were vastly affected by this calamity, and for the rehabilitation of the different areas that were destroyed by the super typhoon, as well as the restoration of the livelihood of the people affected.




