RESOLUTION NO. 7

Series of 2013

“Recommending the Development of a Registry of Convicted Crime Offenders for Purposes of Ensuring the Protection of the Kasambahay”

WHEREAS, President Benigno S. Aquino III has signed into law Republic Act No. 10361 or ‘An Act Instituting Policies for the Protection and Welfare of Domestic Workers’, commonly known as the “Kasambahay Law” on 18 January 2013;

WHEREAS, the statute sets a standard salary for domestic workers, defines their labor rights, and provides entitlement to social benefits provided under existing laws such as the Social Security System, Philhealth, and Pag-Ibig;

WHEREAS, the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG), together with the Local Government Units (LGUs), is mandated to sustain peace and order situation and ensure public safety;

WHEREAS, as the principal law agency of the government, the Department of Justice (DOJ) administers the criminal justice system in accordance with the accepted processes thereof consisting in the investigation of the crimes, prosecution of offenders and administration of the correctional system, including the maintenance of records of convicted crime offenders;

WHEREAS, the labor and employer sector representatives of the TIPC recognize the importance of ensuring the promotion and protection of the well-being of the kasambahay, by safeguarding them, especially the working children, even before the onset of employment;

WHEREAS, as a precautionary measure to avert the kasambahay from going to employers with a history of offenses, the TIPC requests that a registry or database of convicted crime offenders, particularly sexual offenders, child molesters, felons with history of abusing their kasambahays, be developed and disseminated in conspicuous places, such as in all barangays, for easy access of working children, parents of kasambahay, and LGUs, among others.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that we, the members of the National Tripartite Industrial Peace Council (NTIPC), constituted through Republic Act No. 10395, An Act Strengthening Tripartism, Amending for the Purpose Article 275 of the Presidential Decree No. 442, as amended, otherwise known as the Labor Code of the Philippines, request that:


1. Department of Interior and Local Government and Local Government Units develop and maintain a registry or list of convicted crime offenders throughout the country, and advise the kasambahay of its possible implications; and
2. Department of Justice publicize its list of convicted crime offenders, particularly sexual offenders, child molesters, felons with history of abusing their workers, in its website and in every barangay.
