

## **NWAMPC Receives WODP Training Grant**

The National Workers Association of Movie Production Checkers (NWAMPC) received a training grant from the Bureau of Labor Relations through the DOLE Workers' Organization Development Program (WODP).

The grant shall be utilized for the conduct of the NWAMPC's capacity building program for officers and members entitled "Enhancing Skills on Leadership and Organizational Management Workshop" on 29-30 March 2018 at Terre Verde Farm and Resort, Indang, Cavite.

The two-day capability building activity focuses on leadership skills, values enhancement, communication skills, strategic planning and SWOT analysis. The activity seeks to enhance the leadership capability of the officers and committee leaders of the association taking into consideration the existing labor and industrial relations framework.

A total of 40 NWAMPC officers and members are expected to attend the training. Resource speakers will talk about leadership skills, values enhancement, and communication skills.

The activity includes a workshop on action planning. Data and information gathered during the activity shall serve as inputs to the NWAMPC Strategic Action Plan for 2018 and beyond. "The formulated action plan will be the basis of the organization's re-entry plan. The assessed activities identifying gaps and weaknesses of the organization will be corrected and filled-up for the eventual success of our programs," said NWAMPC President, Ms. Eden R. Querubin

BLR Director Benjo Santos Benavidez said that WODP aims to enhance the capabilities of labor organizations and their members in the areas of leadership, organizational development and management including labor and employment laws and policies through provision of training assistance and support.
