RESOLUTION NO. 10

Series of 2013

"Calling on the Civil Service Commission and the Department of Labor and Employment to Pursue the Ratification of ILO Labour Relations (Public Service) Convention, 1978 (No.151)"

WHEREAS, pursuant to Republic Act No. 10395 (An Act Strengthening Tripartism, Amending for the Purpose Article 275 of the Presidential Decree No. 442, as amended otherwise known as the Labor Code of the Philippines), the TIPC is mandated to monitor the full implementation and compliance of concerned sectors with the provisions of all tripartite instruments, including international conventions and declarations, codes of conduct, and social accords;

WHEREAS, the Labour Relations (Public Service) Convention, 1978 (No. 151), which guarantees government workers the rights to organize and bargain collectively, and establishes that disputes related to the determination of the terms and conditions of employment should be resolved through negotiations or through impartial and independent machinery has not yet been ratified by the Philippine Government;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 18, Article II in relation to Section 8, Article III of the 1987 Philippine Constitution, the State guarantees the right of the people, including those employed in the public and private sectors, to form unions, associations, or societies for purposes not contrary to law shall not be abridged;

WHEREAS, the Platform and Policy Pronouncements on Labor and Employment of the present administration include aligning our country's labor policies with international treaties and ILO Conventions;

WHEREAS, the tripartite partners take note that the ratification of ILO Convention No. 151 is a commitment under the Philippine Labor and Employment Plan 2011-2016;

WHEREAS, the ratification of ILO Convention No. 151 would not only align our policies with international labor standards but would also demonstrate the State's commitment to further promote freedom of association and the right to self-organization, particularly in the public sector;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED to call on the government agencies to pursue the ratification of ILO Convention No. 151.
