"Recognizing and Commending the DOLE and the NLRC Efforts to Afford Speedy and Efficient
Delivery of Labor Justice through the
DOLE Project SpeED (Speedy and Efficient Delivery of Labor Justice)"

WE, the representatives of organized labor, employers and government in the National Tripartite Industrial Peace Council (TIPC), duly reconstituted through Executive Order No. 49, Series of 1998, as amended, and fully functioning pursuant to ILO Convention No. 144:

UNANIMOUSLY, recognize the implementation of DOLE Project SpeED 1, 2, and 3 (Speedy and Efficient Delivery of Labor Justice) as a reform measure that seeks to facilitate the resolution of labor cases pending with various offices of the Department of Labor and Employment and its attached agencies;

UNANIMOUSLY, recognize that DOLE Project SpeED 1, 2, and 3, complemented with the 30-day mandatory conciliation-mediation scheme under the Single-Entry Approach (SEnA), set to attain a 98 percent disposition rate of all pending cases enrolled under the Project by 30 April 2011, and the actual disposition rate are as follows;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, AS WE HEREBY RESOLVE, to confer this commendation to the officials and staff of the Department of Labor and Employment (Legal Service, Bureau of Labor Relations, Bureau of Working Conditions, and Regional Offices), National Labor Relations Commission, National Conciliation and Mediation Board, Employees Compensation Commission, and the Philippine Overseas Employment Administration, for their work and commitment to settle labor disputes speedily and efficiently for a better labor justice administration in the country.

RESOLVE FURTHER, that a copy of this Resolution be furnished to the Office of the President for the information and guidance of President Benigno S. Aquino III.
