

ALU-TUCP Receives Training Grant from the Bureau of Labor Relations

The Associated Labor Union-Trade Union Congress of the Philippines (ALU-TUCP) received a training grant from the Bureau of Labor Relations through the DOLE Workers' Organization Development Program (WODP).

The grant was utilized in the conduct of ALU-TUCP's capability-building activity entitled "*National Workshop on Enhancing Workers' Participation in Labor Inspection and Labor Laws Compliance at Work*" on 15-18 August 2018 at Nalusuan Resort in Cebu.

The three-day training activity was conducted to enhance trade union participation in labor inspection. The activity focused on the discussion of the salient features of the DOLE Labor Laws Compliance System, including the workers' role in inspection and monitoring of compliance. Discussed also were the gaps and problems in the LLCS implementation as well as recommendations to facilitate enterprise compliance, resolve cases and improve existing inspection practices.

Twenty-two (22) participants composed of ALU officers, regional industrial relations officers, and deputized labor inspectors attended the activity.

Mr. Gerardo R. Seno, National Executive Vice President of ALU-TUCP, extended his appreciation to the BLR for always supporting their training programs. "The activity upgraded ALU-TUCPs institutional capacity to contribute to the government's labor inspection system and compliance-related campaigns," he said.

Workers capability development is a component of the WODP, under which assistance and support, through training grants, are extended to qualified workers' organizations to enhance competency and skills in the management of their organization.
