

BLR Orients DOLE VIII on Online Union Registration System



The Bureau of Labor Relations conducted an orientation on the Online Union Registration System (OURS) to the labor relations focal persons of DOLE Regional Office VIII on 05 October 2018 in Tacloban City.

Field office heads and program managers attended the activity aimed at introducing the OURS to the regional personnel. A simulation on the submission of application for registration to the issuance of certificate of registration through the OURS was conducted during the activity.

Ms. Marivic Villa, Chief of the BLR Union Registration and Workers Empowerment Division, discussed the different mechanics and features of the online system from accomplishing the application form to attaching the necessary documents.

Mr. Raymart Aborque of the Planning Service provided technical assistance and guided the participants in using the system.

Ms. Villa on behalf of the BLR expressed her gratitude to the Region 8 for having the initiative to enhance further their knowledge on OURS. She emphasized the relevance of the OURS in relation to the workers' right to self-organization and collective bargaining.

The OURS was developed to operationalize the online registration for unions, collective bargaining agreements and workers' associations pursuant to DOLE

Department Order No. 40-I-15, Series of 2015. It was designed to enhance the online transactional processing system (TPS) which pre-processes, collects, stores, modifies and retrieves registration transactions of labor organizations and workers' associations. It is also a central database system with accurate and real time information.
