

BLR Joins CSC's 2019 R.A.C.E to Serve Fun Run



The Bureau of Labor Relations joined thousands of runners from different government agencies in the Civil Service Commission (CSC) 2019 R.A.C.E. to Serve Fun Run held at the Quirino Grandstand in Manila on 01 September 2019.

The R.A.C.E. to Serve Fun Run is an annual activity of the CSC which serves as a kick-off activity for the month-long Philippine Civil Service Anniversary every September. The fun run is also a fund raising activity wherein proceeds from the event will go to the Pondong Pamanang Lingkod Bayani (PLBi) Program which honors public servants who sacrificed their lives in the service of the Filipino people. Public servants who died in the line of duty shall be given one-time financial assistance of Php100,000.00, a plaque of recognition and scholarship grants to the deceased employees' immediate family member.

On its 199th year, the Civil Service theme of this year's celebration is *"Civil Service at 119: Upholding Integrity and Building a High-Trust Society"*. The theme is anchored on one of the AmBisyon 2040's key areas for development planning which is building a high-trust society.
