

Relief Drive: BLR Connects through Outreach Program

To commemorate the 63rd Founding Anniversary of the Bureau of Labor Relations (BLR), the BLR organized an outreach program for the evacuees of Taal Volcano eruption who are in the National Shrine of Saint Padre Pio in Batangas on 17 January 2020.



A total of one hundred forty-eight (148) families composed of five hundred sixty individuals benefitted from the provided basic needs such as grocery items, hygiene kits, toiletries and other personal care supplies distributed.

The BLR recognizes the much needed support for our displaced kababayans

in these trying times. On behalf of the evacuees, the coordinator from the National Shrine of Saint Padre Pio welcomed the BLR staff and extended gratitude for the donations.

On 12 January 2020, Taal Volcano started to spew lava fountains and triggered ash fall which spread in Batangas and other parts of the Calabarzon Region, as well as in some parts of Metro Manila and Central Luzon.
