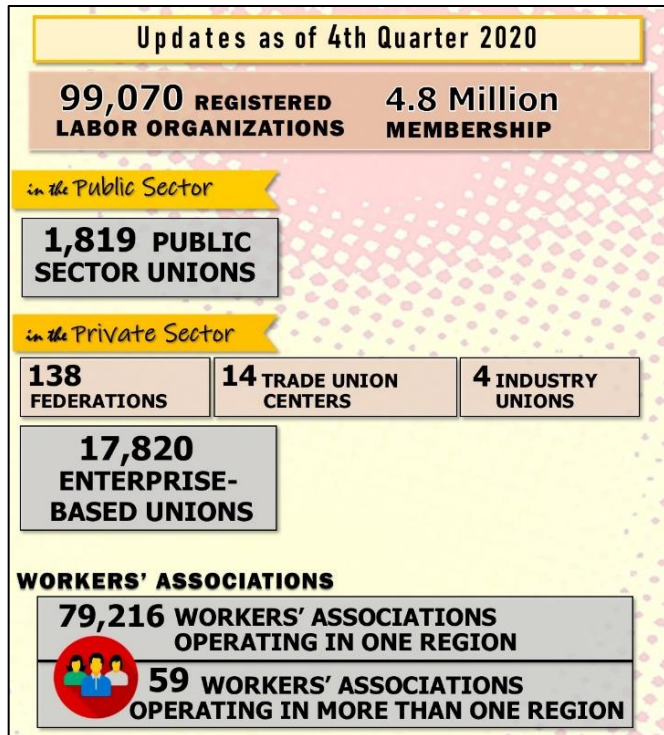


REGISTERED LABOR ORGANIZATIONS INCREASED BY 10%

As of the December 2020, a total of 99,070 labor organizations were registered nationwide with more than 4.7 million membership. This constitute to an increase of about 10% or 8,643 from the 90,427 recorded registration over the same period in the previous year.

Of the registered labor organizations in 2020, eighty percent (80%) or 79,275 are workers' associations, 18% or 17,976 are private sector labor organizations and 2% or 1,819 are public sector unions.



For the workers' associations, about 99% or 79,216 are workers' associations operating in one region while 1% or 59 are workers associations operating in more than one region. The number of registered workers associations increased by 12% or 8,467 from the 70,808 registrations in 2019.

Moreover, the registered private sector labor organizations is composed of 17,820 enterprise-based unions, 138 federations, 14 trade union centers and four (4) industry unions. From the previous year, about 126 new registrations were added in this sector.

For the public sector unions, about 47% or 850 are from Local Government Units (LGU), 31% or 568 are from National Government Agencies (NGA), 13% or 231 are from State Universities and Colleges (SUC), and 9% or 170 are from National Government Association (NGA). The number of registered public sector unions increased by 50 from the 1,769 registrations in 2019.
