During the LEGS seminar, Director Bacay oriented the participants on the employer-employee relationship and rights and obligations of employees and employers. She discussed that employees are entitled to the minimum terms, conditions, and benefits of employment, security of tenure, safe working conditions, right to self-organization and collective bargaining, and equality in the workplace. On the other hand, employers have the prerogative to make decisions and actions over all aspects of business but

is subject to the rights of workers based on law and contract.

The participants consisted of Grade 12 students, class advisers, career guidance advocates, BCGANI officers and members, education program supervisors, PESO managers and job placement officers.
