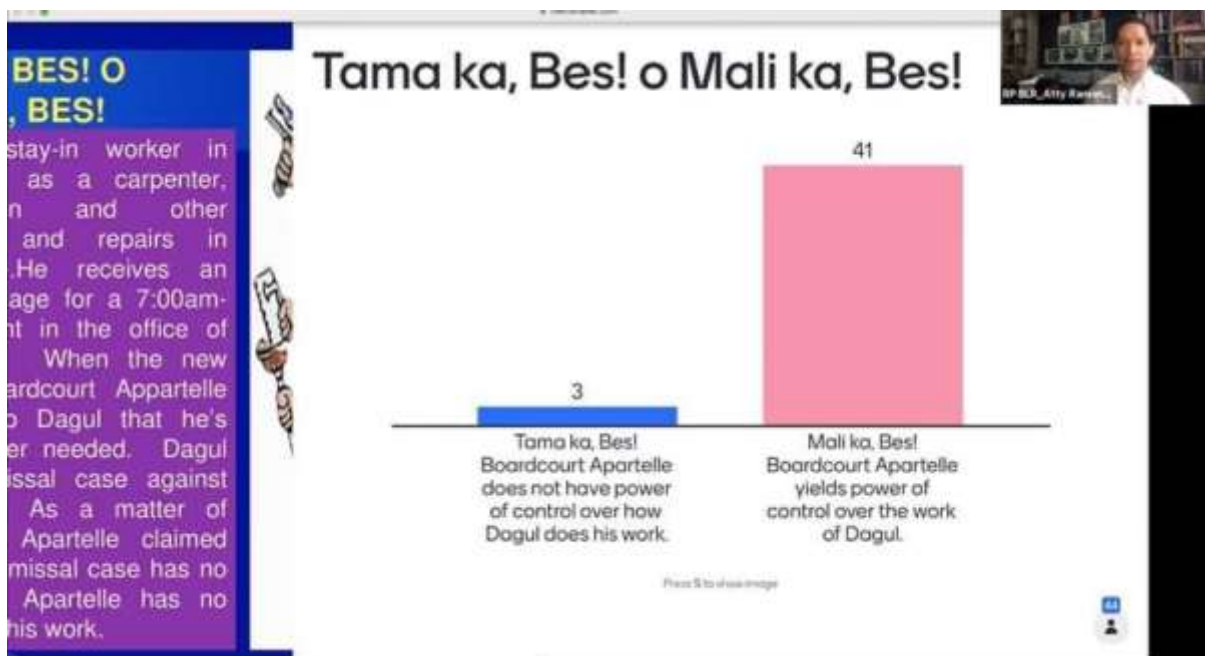


BLR Orients Labor Inspectors on Labor Relations

The Department of Labor and Employment conducted its 3rd Labor Inspectors Capacity Building for 2021. BLR Mediator Arbiter, Atty. Ramon Saura III, was one of the resource persons on the Level 1B – Basic Course for Labor Inspectors on 27 – 28 May 2021 via Zoom Teleconferencing.

The training aimed to further capacitate the labor inspectors in the conduct of their duties and responsibilities under the new normal scheme.

Atty. Saura III discussed the employer-employee relationship, kinds of employees, right to security of tenure, basic evidence, and Department Order No. 174, Series of 2017 on Contracting and Subcontracting. Under the new normal, Atty. Saura III made use of Mentimeter to create an interactive session where he engaged the participants using their smartphones or laptops.



Aside from labor relations, the participants took lessons and examinations on general labor standards, occupational safety and health standards, social legislations and

other labor laws and regulations.



The training was organized by the Bureau of Working Conditions and Human Resource Development Service and was participated by forty-seven (47) labor inspectors nationwide.
