

BLR Successfully Recertified to QMS ISO 9001:2015



The Bureau of Labor Relations (BLR) has been successfully recertified with International Organization for Standardization (ISO) 9001:2015 for another three years covering the

provision of government service related to labor and employment.

The Bureau is more determined to implement and maintain its quality management system after it completed and passed the reassessment conducted by an ISO third party auditor, SOCOTEC Certification Philippines, Inc., last June 2021.

The Certification of Registration for the ISO 9001:2015 was officially conferred to BLR on 24 September 2018 with validity until July 2021. The auditors reassessed the BLR and declared its continued compliance with ISO 9001:2015.

The external audit covered BLR programs and projects such as design and development, monitoring and evaluation, disposition of appealed cases, and registration of federation/national union/workers association.

The reassessment audit showed the Bureau's continued conformity and compliance to the standards in delivering services that are efficient



and responsive to its clients.

The DOLE QMS is a continual strategic program of the Department towards ensuring transparency, accountability, efficiency and effectiveness in its operations to consistently meet the ever-changing needs of its clients.

The recertification for the ISO 9001:2015 was officially conferred to BLR on 13 July 2021 valid until July 2024.
