



FACE-TO-FACE TRAINING ON UNION ADMINISTRATION AND FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT CONDUCTED THRU WODP

About thirty (30) union leaders and members participated in the Advanced Course on Trade Union Administration and Financial Management held on June 18, 2022 at the FFW Building, Malate, Manila. The Federation of Free Workers (FFW) facilitated the training, which was funded by the Bureau of Labor Relations (BLR) through the Workers Organization and Development Program (WODP). The BLR, through WODP, provides training grants to qualified workers' organizations to enhance their competency and skills in the management of their organizations.

The conducted training aimed to familiarize the participants on state policies, legal and commitment frameworks on trade unionism, and some principles and concepts on trade union administration. The rights of legitimate labor organizations, and the rights and conditions of membership as mandated by the Labor Code of the Philippines were also emphasized during the training.

As an important aspect of union administration, the participants learned about the proper way of preparing and recording Financial Reports. They also developed their digital skills, and were introduced to different social media communication platforms available today.
